Stephen A. Mitchell Award 2022

Established by *Psychoanalytic Psychology* and the Board of the Division of Psychoanalysis, the Stephen A. Mitchell Award honors our esteemed late colleague, Stephen A. Mitchell, along with a graduate student whose paper is deemed exemplary by a panel of judges.

The winner of the 2022 Stephen A. Mitchell Award is Ekta Srivastava for her paper "Home in Border Crossings: A Psychoanalytic Study of Dislocations in the Lives of Female Domestic Workers."

Ekta Srivastava is currently a doctoral candidate at the Department of Psychosocial and Psychoanalytic Studies, University of Essex. Her present research seeks to explore the relational dialectics of home and dislocation in the lives of women living in urban villages in New Delhi. Her interests lie chiefly in critical psychoanalysis, cultural psychology, phenomenology, and explorations of and through art and language. She is also committed to psychosocial therapeutic engagement and has been involved with support work at a refugee camp for several months.
